Enrolling in CurrentCare and VLER helps all your providers coordinate care and have the information they need when they need it to provide you with better care.

CurrentCare, Rhode Island's Health Information Exchange (HIE), ensures that your healthcare team can access your health information. Your providers access your information through our secure system. Providers at the VAMC now have access to your CurrentCare data right in their own Electronic Health Record!

Connect Your Docs



By authorizing VLER, the Virtual Lifetime Electronic Record, key parts of your health record from the Veterans Affairs Medical Center (National) are shared with your local providers. VLER 'Connect(s) Your Docs' and reduces the need for Veterans to request and carry paper copies of your own medical records.

If you are enrolled in CurrentCare and you sign-up for VLER, your VAMC health information will be available for your providers directly!
