With CurrentCare, providers and staff can log into the Viewer to find critical health information they need for the patients they treat. Staff at the Providence VAMC can also see this data right in their EHR (VisA Web)!

In order for VAMC data to be shared into CurrentCare, Veterans need to authorize VLER: the Virtual Lifetime Electronic Record. Once VLER is signed, providers in the community can access the data they need for better care coordination.

In order for your patients' health information to be available in CurrentCare and at the VAMC, your patients need to enroll in BOTH CurrentCare and VLER.

With CurrentCare:

- Avoid duplicate lab and imaging tests
- Be alerted to changes in your medications
- Have access to other critical details needed to provide you with the best care

Get plugged in to Better Care!



By enrolling your patients in CurrentCare, Rhode Island's Health Information Exchange (HIE), providers and clinical staff gain critical access to patient health information.

Providers in the community can access the patient health record through our secure system, the CurrentCare Viewer. Additionally, medical professionals at the VAMC now have access to CurrentCare data right in their Electronic Health Record (VistA Web)!

Once a Veteran signs VLER, their VAMC data will be available in the CurrentCare Viewer!

Look in the Clinical Documents section to find:

- Radiology Reports
- Consult Notes
- A Medical Summarization (CCD) including medications, lab results and more!

By authorizing VLER, The Virtual Lifetime Electronic Record, key parts of Veterans' health records from the Veterans Affairs Medical Center (National) are shared with providers in the community. VLER "Connect(s) Your Docs" reduces the need for Veterans to request and carry paper copies of their own medical records.

If a patient is enrolled in CurrentCare and signs-up for VLER, their VAMC health information will be available for their community care team directly in the CurrentCare Viewer!
